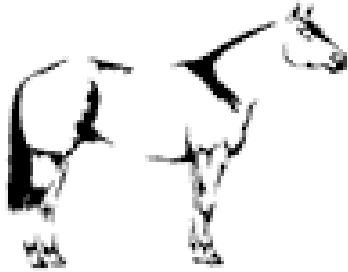

Rider agrees to assume any and all risks involved in or arising from Rider's use of or presence upon Manager's facilities including, without limitation but not limited to, the risks of death, bodily injury, property damage, falls, kicks, bites, collisions with vehicles, horses or stationary objects, or the negligence or deliberate act of another person. Rider agrees to hold Manager and all its successors, assignees, members and/or officers completely harmless and not liable and release them from all liability whatsoever and agrees not to sue them on account of or in connection with any claims, causes of action, injuries, damages, costs or expenses arising out of Rider's use of or presence upon Manager's facilities including, without limitation but not limited to, the risks of death, bodily injury, property damage, including consequential damage, except if the damages are caused by the direct, willful and wanton negligence of the Manager. Rider agrees to indemnify and defend Manager against, and holds it harmless from, any and all claims, causes of action, damages, judgments, costs or expenses, including attorney's fees, which in any way arise from Rider's use of or presence upon Manager's facilities. Rules

- 1) Proof of age is required with your entry form, NO EXCEPTIONS. (*driver's license, school ID, birth certificate, etc..*)
- 2) Points will be carried one horse, one rider only only. Each rider will be issued their own entry number.
- 3) To be eligible for High Point, the Rider must show in three out of four shows. Rider must show in at least one halter or showmanship class and three performance classes. All classes entered will count towards high point except Sub-Juniors age group.
- 4) Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated and will result in the rider and rider's party being excused from the show grounds, loss of entry fees paid and loss of points earned that day.
- 5) Our judges will be available at their discretion AFTER the completion of the show. Attempting to discuss placing or judge's decisions while the show is still going on will result in the rider being excused from the grounds. This policy is to ensure that the show continues to run smoothly. All judges' decisions are final.
- 6) Please address all questions to the show personnel. Any disputes over points, placing or any other matter will be discussed with the director and a non bias member of the show personnel in private.
- 7) Protest will require a \$150 non refundable fee. Fee and written protest are due to the show manager before the close of the protested show. BCFA Executive Board of Directors will review the protest at their monthly meeting following the show. The protest will be upheld only with a majority vote of the Board of Directors. If the protest is upheld, the resulting action of the protest will be in effect at the next scheduled show.
- 8) At the completion of the last class of the day (western riding), high point, and reserve high point place points will be tabulated. We will not give you point standings through the day.
- 9) Rider must sign for prizes when picked up. If you do not pick up your prize it will be available for you to pick up until the last show of the series, after that the prizes will be held for use at our next event.
- 10) Each class has a maximum value of 6 points. The following is how they will be distributed.

- 11) Ties for series or daily high point ties will be broken in the following manner. First, the number of 1st places won during the daily/series will be counted. If a tie still exists the number of 2nd places won will be counted. This will continue thru 6th place. In the event that a tie still exists a coin toss will determine the winner.
- 12) Your horses name on the Coggins needs to match their registered name, if registered. A negative Coggins is required to enter the show and must be presented with entry, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 13) Not knowing the rules of the series is not an excuse. These rules will be made available to everyone at every show. They will be handed out with each entry number at our first show of the series and available at each following show.
- 14) **There are NO refunds.** Only enter the classes you are sure you can compete in.
- 15) If you do not close our check we will close it for you. If you have a returned check you will be charged a \$25.00 returned check fee, will no longer be able to write checks at our series and will be required to pay cash.
- 16) Once the gate closes on a class NO ONE will be allowed to enter the pen. NO EXCEPTIONS. There will be three calls for the class. Halter class books will close at 8:45am so that we can prepare to start those classes on time. We will do our best to keep you up to date with where we are in the show thru our announcers. It is your responsibility however, to make sure you get in your class on time.
- 17) **Series:** In each qualifying age division a series High Point Champion will be rewarded a trophy saddle. Reserve High Point age division champion will receive a trophy buckle. 3rd Place age division will receive a trophy saddle blanket.

THE NUMBER ONE RULE IS TO HAVE FUN AND ENJOY THIS TIME WITH YOUR HORSE AND YOUR HORSE LOVING FRIENDS. REMEMBER WHEN IT IS HOT TO WATER YOURSELF AND YOUR HORSE.
